

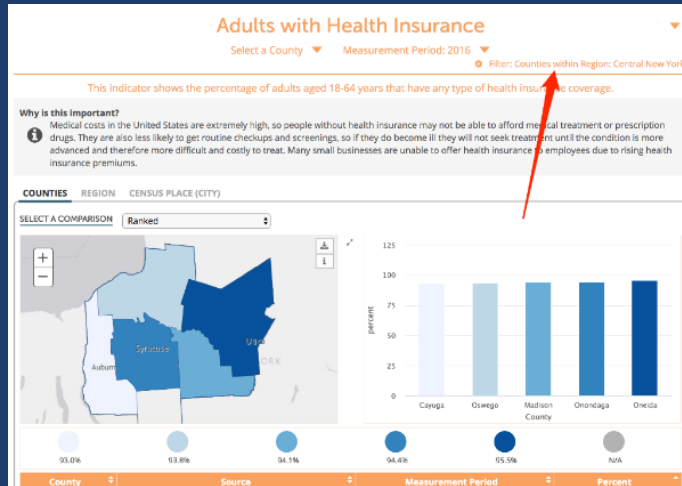
# March 2018 Product Releases

## Filter by Location

You can now filter the indicator detail page to only display locations within a state, county, region, or service area, when available. For example, if you are viewing an indicator at the zip code level you can filter the page to only display zip codes within a selected location.



## Order Dashboards by Comparisons and Value

The sort by comparison option is designed to help identify high need indicators. By using the sort by comparison option and selecting a comparison of interest, your search results are ordered from worst to best based on how they compare to the selection. Selecting value will order the results by unit (i.e. percent, count, etc.) and indicator value.

**Build a Customized Dashboard**

In the fields below, search for indicators by location, topics, age group, classification, subgroup, or comparison. No fields are required, but we suggest selecting a location or two to start.
